## 1 吉隆坡 ✈️ 关西

(机上用餐)

📍 集合于吉隆坡国际机场，乘搭飞往关西。

## 2 关西 🚌 奈良 🚌 大阪

(-/午/-)

📍 奈良公园 — 作为奈良的代表性旅游景点而闻名的都市公园，毗邻东大寺、兴福寺及春日大社等世界遗产。

📍 大阪城公园 (外观) — 是位于大阪市中央区的大型绿地公园及停留拍照于大阪城是大阪的象征。

📍 道顿堀 & 心斋桥 — 好客的大阪早在江户时代就以商业和娱乐闻名。在心斋桥，在灯火通明的道顿堀区，您会发现大阪最好的购物和餐饮场所。

## 3 大阪 🚌 京都 🚌 名古屋

(早/午/晚)

📍 岚山渡月桥 — 架于大堰川上，上游称作保津川，下游则是桂川。桥大约是在834年~848年左右建好，而之后大约是在1259年~1274年开始被称为渡月桥。1934年有用钢筋水泥重新整修桥墩，而桥上的扶手栏杆则使用桧木制，设计成让它能融入岚山美景中的样式。

📍 岚山竹林步道 — 飘荡着幽雅香气的竹林宛如被深绿色包围的梦幻空间，是岚山最具代表性的风景。这条小径经常出现在电影或电视剧上的场景中，早晨或黄昏时造访更能感受其独特气息。

📍 清水寺 — 京都最古老的寺院，1994年列入世界文化遗产名录。清水舞台下方，抬头仰望，可以清楚地看到这个用巨型榉木柱并排支撑的“悬造式”建筑，没有使用一枚钉子，非常壮观。途径清水寺的石板路两旁可都是各式各样的商店，每一间都各有特色。

📍 伏见稻荷大社 — 入口处叠立着由丰臣秀吉与1589年捐赠的大鸟居，后面是神社的主殿及其他建筑物，尤以“千本鸟居”最为著名。是京都代表性景观之一，狐狸被视为神明稻荷的使者，因此在神社里你会看到各式的狐狸石像。

## 4 名古屋 🚌 富士河口湖町

(早/午/晚)

📍 滨名湖 — 距离东京大约2.5小时车程，拥有美丽的风景。

📍 忍野八海 — 位于忍野村的涌泉群，因为错落有致地散布着八个清泉而得名。

📍 大石公园 — 大石公园的亮点是湖水、盛开的薰衣草和富士山的壮丽景色。我们特别建议晴天无风的清晨前往。然后，您将能够看到“倒富士”，这座标志性的山峰倒映在平静的湖水中。

## 5 富士河口湖町 🚌 箱根 🚌 东京

(早/午/晚)

📍 箱根神社 — 这里是有着红漆涂装的鸟居和杉木的行道树，在神圣的气氛中默默诉说着历史的神社。

📍 大涌谷地热奇景 (不含缆车) — 为300年前火山爆发的山口。登上山顶，有用火山温泉煮熟的「黑鸡蛋」，据日本人说吃一个可长寿7年。

📍 芦之湖(含船游) — 被箱根的山群环绕的芦之湖。除兜风和散心外，还可以乘坐游览船享受湖上的绝色美景。

**1** Kuala Lumpur  Kansai (MOB)

 Assembly at airport, depart to Kansai.




**2** Kansai  Nara  Osaka (-/ /-)

-  **Nara Park** — A city park famed as a sightseeing spot representing Nara. World Heritage sites such as Todai-ji Temple, Kofuku-ji Temple and Kasuga-taisha Shrine are close to each other.
-  **Osaka Castle (Outlook)** — One of the famous landmarks in Japan. Its played a major role in the unification of Japan during the 16 century of Azuchi-Momoyama period.
-  **Dotonbori & Shinzaibashi** — Hospitable Osaka established its reputation for commerce and entertainment back in the Edo period.





**3** Osaka  Kyoto  Nagoya (B/ /D)

-  **Togetsukyo Bridge** — The bridge was built between 834 and 848 and was named “Togetsukyo” sometime between 1259 and 1274. It was rebuilt in 1934 with a concrete foundation, but the balustrade on the top part of the bridge is made of cypress and is designed to blend with the natural beauty of Arashiyama.
-  **Chikurin-no-Michi (bamboo forest)** — Chikurin-no-Michi is a magical space filled with the fresh scent of bamboo and lush greenery, embodying the beauty of Arashiyama. It has appeared in a number of movies and TV series. The best times to visit are early morning and dusk to enjoy the atmosphere.
-  **Kiyomizu Temple** — It is the oldest temple in Kyoto and was included in the World Cultural Heritage in 1994. Under the clear water stage, looking up, you can clearly see the suspended building supported by giant eucalyptus columns side by side, without the use of nail.
-  **Fushimi Inari Taisha** — At the entrance stands the Big Bird House donated by Toyotomi Hideyoshi in 1589. Especially the “Thousands of Birds” is the most famous. It is one of the representative landscapes of Kyoto. Here you will see a variety of fox statues in the shrine.

**4** Nagoya  Fujikawaguchiko (B/ /D)

-  **Lake Hamana** — Lake Hamana boasts beautiful scenery, marine sports, fishing, cycling, and fun activities like fruit picking and an amusement park.
-  **Oshino Hakkai** — Named after its well-proportioned eight ponds.
-  **Oishi Park** — Oishi Park's highlight is the sublime scenery of the lake, the blossoming lavender, and Mt. Fuji in one picture. We especially recommend going early in the morning on sunny days without wind. Then, you'll be






**5** Fujikawaguchiko  Hokane  Tokyo (B/ /D)

-  **Hakone Shrine** — The Hakone Shrine with its vermilion-lacquered torii (Shinto shrine archway) and its Japanese cedars is a shrine with a holy presence that tells you about history.
-  **Owakudani (Exclude ropeway)** — An area with active volcanic zone where sulphurous fumes, its “Black jewel eggs” cooked in the area's thermal heat sources, are a Hakone specialty.
-  **Lake Ashi (Include boat ride)** — Lake Ashinoko is surrounded by the mountains of Hakone. You can go for a drive or take a stroll, and you can also take the Pleasure Cruise to enjoy the splendid view from the lake.

**7** Sapporo  Kuala Lumpur (B/ /-)

-  **Tsukiji Outer Market** — Once the world's largest fish markets. The sight of the many kinds of fresh seafood and the busy atmosphere around makes it a major tourist attraction in Tokyo.
-  **Sensoji Temple** — A Buddhist temple located in Asakusa. It is one of the most colourful and popular temples in Tokyo. The symbol of Asakusa is at the main entrance, which called “Kaminari Gate”.
-  **Nakamise Shopping Street** — There are around 90 shops along the street, where it is a best place for you to buy snacks and souvenir.
-  **Diver City Tokyo** — Large-scale commercial facilities integrating shopping, fun and dining.
-  **Transfer to Airport for flight back home.**
