♀ 集合于吉隆坡国际机场,飞往千岁。

小樽

(-/午/晚)

- ♀ 小樽步行街 结合漫步、选购精品和品尝甜点的好地方。这里涵盖著名的北一哨子玻璃饰品专卖地,以及音乐盒博物馆、 咖啡厅、冰淇淋和甜点店。途径小樽著名地标——小樽运河。
- 因1943(昭和18)年有珠山喷发而从平坦土地上降起的山。山顶上的塔状熔岩凸起的形状被称为降起性火山 ♀ 邵和新山 。目前山体已变为红褐色, 仍在不断喷烟。
- 饲养约数十头北海道棕熊。在这里,您可以购买苹果或饼干喂食棕熊。 熊牧场(含门票)
- 位於洞爺湖半山腰上,距離洞爺湖溫泉街市區約莫15分鐘的車程,交通方便。展望台不只可以一覽洞爺湖的 ♀ 筒倉展望台 美景,一旁也有直昇機遊覽導覽的服務,還可以看到不少搭乘直升機遊覽的旅客,別有一番樂趣。

(早/午/晚) 洞爷 函馆

- 这是一座国家指定公园,背靠海拔约1131米的优美山峦驹岳,境内包含大沼湖、小沼湖、莼菜沼等。湖沼因 ♥ 大沼国定公园 驹岳喷发而形成、湖面上漂浮着126座大小岛屿。
- ♀ 函館植物园園 使用源头泉水的热带植物园。多角形的植物园内种有约300种、3000株热带植物。从每年12月致次年5月黄金 周期间,还可以在室外的猴山看到猴子的身影。另设有足浴浴场。
- ♀ 元町 是新旧名店汇集的时尚商店街,以元町通为中心排列着数百家老字号品牌店、各类特色店等。
- 乘坐索道缆车前往函馆山山顶,欣赏世界三大夜景之一的函馆百万夜景。 ☑ 函馆山夜景 (含缆车)

函馆 机幌 (早/午/-)

- 在开阔的景色中享受北海道的冬季戏雪乐趣(雪上摩托车、雪盆、雪上香蕉船)。 ♀ 雪上乐园
- ♀ 旧道厅 一栋巴罗克风格以欧式红砖建造的官署建筑,是北海道最高行政机关厅的所在地。
- 为日本19世纪引入西方教育以及北海道开垦时期的象征。时计台位于札幌市中心的大楼间,钟声鸣响持续了 ♥ 时计台 120年以上。
- 大通公园是一整块长方形的绿化地带位于札幌中心。花坛一年四季都被各种鲜花装点着,还有不断变化造型 ♥ 大通公园 的喷泉、景色宜人。
- ♀ 狸小路商店街 札幌市著名的购物街,拥有超过150家的店铺,包括饮食、服饰、药妆、土产店等等。

(早/午/晚) 札幌

- ▼ 旭山动物园 (含门票) 旭山动物园强调以动物本身为理念设置园区、保留动物最自然、原始的生活环境、并设计可让旅客近距离旁 观动物生活的空间。每年冬季限定的企鹅散步秀,更是北海道观光的重点之一。
- 由"青叶"、"Ittetsu庵松田"、"石田"、"拉面屋天金"、"梅光轩"、"工房加藤拉面"、"齐场"、"山头火"等8家店铺 ♀ 旭川拉面村 构成。
- 是在森林中展开的购物区。木制长廊上分布着 15 间小屋,每间小屋都有自己的主题和工艺。一个梦幻般的 ♀ 森林精灵露台 空间,看起来就像仙女一样。

札幌 (早/午/晚)

- ♀ 二条市场 明治时期的札幌市民食堂,深受人们喜爱。现在则完全成了观光胜地。约50家生鲜店铺鳞次栉比。
- ♀ 北海道神宮 北海道最具代表性,并且是规模最大的神宮。
- ♀ 白色恋人公园 白色恋人巧克力的生产地,更是一座洋溢着英伦气息的欧式古典城堡。
- ♀ 名牌厂商直销店 除了国际品牌以外还有很多日本本土品牌进驻,不定期还有超值的减价促销活动。

(-/L/D)Chitose Otaru Tova **Otaru Handicraft Street** Renowned for its glass handicrafts, music box museum, ice-cream & dessert shops. A perfect place for a stroll, souvenir shopping and to satisfy your sweet tooth! Drive pass Otaru Canal, one of the landmarks of Otaru. Mount Showa-Shinzan In 1943, Mt. Usu erupted and formed a protuberance, more commonly known as a lava dome, in the plains below it: Mt. Showa-Shinzan. Smoke continues to erupt from its rusty surface. **Bear Ranch** You can feed the Hokkaido brown bears with apples or cookies by own expenses. (Include Entrance ticket) Shikotsu Toya National You can see the whole Toyako and Mt Usu Nakajima island Showashinzan, Toyako town, Nishiyama Crater. Park Silo Observation Deck Hakodate (B/L/D) Toya This national park features Onuma Lake, Konuma Lake, Junsai Swamp, and the 1131-meter-tall Mt. Komaga-Onuma Quasi-National **Park** take as a backdrop. This marshland was produced in the wake of an eruption from Mt. Komagatake, and some 126 islands dot its surface. **Hakodate Tropical** A tropical botanical garden, heated by a hot spring. Its polygonal greenhouse contains around 3000 tropical **Botanical Garden** plants in 300 varieties. Outside, from December until mid May, you can see monkeys warm themselves up in the Monkey Mountain hot spring. There's also a foot bath. Motomachi offers a uniquely delightful cityscape infused with foreign and Japanese culture. **Hakodate Night View** also known as one of the most beautiful night view of the world. (B/L/-) Hakodate Sapporo Snowland Enjoy Hokkaido winter fun activities (Snowmobiles, snow sled, Snow Banana boat). Former Hokkaido A Baroque style of European-style red brick to build up the official building, Hokkaido highest administrative authority of Hokkaido hall. **Government Office** Sapporo Clock Tower It is a symbol of the introduction of Western education during 19th century. The bell still ringing in the building at the city center of Sapporo for more than 120 years.
